L.I.F.E WORKER SUPERVISOR POSITION DESCRIPTION SUMMER 2025

PURPOSE: This position will offer life experience and an opportunity to participate in the ministry and work of Bedford United Church with a focus on supervision, program planning and children, youth and family ministry.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Oversee, facilitate, and collaborate with the L.I.F.E Workers and their work.
- Participating in the ministry of Bedford United Church and surrounding community through worship and community events.
- Coordinating various programs and projects of the church during their employment (including but not limited to support for Sunday School, Youth Programs, Family Ministry Programs, Outreach Projects, Children's Day Camps, Social Media, events at The Crossing and Worship)
- Coordinating L.I.F.E Workers' participation in Sunday morning worship services as required.
- Participating in property and administration work of the church on an as needed basis.
- Participating with the fullest of themselves and acting in an attitude of care and compassion in all their work.

THE TYPICAL DUTIES OF THE L.I.F.E WORKER SUPERVISOR:

- Facilitate and lead in weekly summer team check-ins.
- Support the L.I.F.E workers in their goals and work.
- Participate in all assigned programs including but not limited to:
 - Children's Day camp
 - Youth Programs
 - Sunday School and Nursery
 - Outreach Projects
 - Events at The Crossing
 - BUC Worship services.
- Contribute fully to assigned work.
- Plan and implement the programs as laid out and make adaptations when necessary.
